VICTORIA HARBOUR

CHEUNG SHA WAN. LANTAU

Lantau's Cheung Sha Wan is a mighty two-mile-long stretch of sandy shore: in fact, the name means 'long sand' in Cantonese. The upper beach is completely undeveloped

and you are guaranteed solitude on a weekday. The lower beach is a more fun place with a handful of well-regarded beachfront restaurants. Tian Tan Buddha, also known as the Big Buddha located at Ngong Ping, is a 10-minute cab ride away from Cheung Sha beach.



TAI LONG WAN AND LONG KE WAN

Practically undeveloped, Tai Long Wan and Long Ke Wan are Hong Kong's gems. Concealed in deep Sai Kung these beaches with soft, white sand and pristine water, reminis-

cent more of Thailand than Hong Kong. The beaches are famous among hikers and surfers for its difficult hiking trail and waves.



Sai Kung town centre acts as a gateway to its vast country parks, unspoiled nature and immaculate beaches, but the town centre — serving as a home to many — buzzes with activity. Be sure to sample

some of the seafood from the plethora of Chinese restaurants lining the waterfront.



SOK KWU WAN. LAMMA

A modest town and fishing pier, Sok Kwu Wan nestles on the eastern front of Lamma Island. Aside from the sumptuous fresh marine food on offer, the town also hosts a Tin Hau temple, a moderate but

rewarding hike inland from the shore.



SOKO ISLANDS

The Soko Islands are a group of islands in Hong Kong. The group consists of Tai A Chau, Siu A Chau and several smaller nearby islands, in the southwestermost waters of the territory, to the southwest

of Lantau Island. Now largely uninhabited, the islands formerly accommodated a refugee camp for Vietnamese boat people. The Sokos have the finest, softest sand around, they're also home to the Chinese white dolphin and various other types of coral and marine life.


